

# IWC Pertinent Dates:

**STARTING May 22<sup>nd</sup> Stage 3:** By special order by Governor due to decreased COVID incidence, limit increased to no more than 100 people allowed to congregate

**June 14<sup>th</sup>, Stage 4:** Facilities are allowed to return to full operation including no limitations on class attendance. Classes will resume on campus on June 15<sup>th</sup>. Social distancing is still recommended and masks are “optional” by regulatory standard in office/classroom settings. IWC will continue to require masks during Hands-on practice/clinic. (Any student in a High Risk population, recently exposed to COVID and requiring self-isolation, or choosing to self-isolate beyond this date is encouraged to consider a Leave of Absence (LOA) or other arrangements to avoid falling behind in classes and failing courses. **June 12<sup>th</sup>:** Esthetics Clinic Opens to full operation including standard attendance guidelines. IWC will continue to require masks during Hands-on practice/clinic.

**June 26<sup>th</sup>:** Massage Clinic Returns to full operation including standard attendance guidelines. IWC will continue to require masks during Hands-on practice/clinic.

**July 3<sup>rd</sup>:** Students in class 20.2 start clinic. IWC will continue to require masks during Hands-on practice/clinic.

**July 4<sup>th</sup>, Stage 5:** Hands-On/Clinic Masks are officially downgraded from “Required” to “Recommended” by state guidelines. IWC operational standard will be determined based upon regional contagion status at that time.
